

Notification/Authorization procedures:

Notification:

The Fire Chief or the Chief's designee shall be notified anytime the following situations occur:

1. Fire fighter death
2. Fire fighter injury requiring hospitalization
3. Civilian death
4. Hazardous materials incidents, in which Berks County EMA was notified and responding

The Officer in Charge should ensure that the Fire Chief or Fire Chief's designee is notified. Should the Fire Chief be unavailable the Assistant Fire Chief will assume the responsibilities of the Fire Chief. In addition, the Township Manager shall be notified.

Authorization:

In the absence of the Fire Chief, authorization of all Fire Department activities shall follow the Cumru Township Organization Chart. Specifically, the Duty Officer has the authorization from the Fire Chief to authorize all Fire Department sanctioned activities as outlined in the Township Ordinance relating to the Cumru Township Fire Department.
