Perform one monthly maintenance check		
Demonstrate use of On Spots and explain when to use and not to use auxiliary braking system (jake brake)		
Produce safe and effective hand line streams. Demonstrate a working knowledge of hand line hydraulic calculations and safe operation of the pump.		
Demonstrate the ability to repack a handline in one of the rear hose trays, as well as the bumper load.		
Demonstrate safe and effective use of all fixed and portable electrical equipment (light tower, portable lighting, fans, hand tools, etc.) using the on-board generator as a power source.		
Setup a Holmatro pump with Spreader, Cutter & RAM. Demonstrate ability to couple and uncouple CORE hose.		
Locate, set up and demonstrate the use of one air tool.		
Locate, set up and demonstrate the use of one air bag. Explain the key points of safety and effective use of the air bag system.		
Attach and operate the removable winch in one location on the apparatus.		
Locate and start one rotary saw. Explain the purpose of various blades carried on the apparatus and demonstrate how to properly change blades.		
Locate and deploy the Little Giant ladder.		
Locate and demonstrate the proper use of one pair of rescue struts.		
Demonstrate proper use of the oil-dry hopper; explain how the hopper is reloaded.		
Explain proper positioning of apparatus for use as an attack engine, supply engine, or vehicle rescue incident.
