

RESOLUTION NO. 843

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CUMRU, COUNTY OF BERKS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, TO ESTABLISH RATES OF PAYMENT FOR THE SEWAGE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

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WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Cumru, Berks County, PA, have adopted ordinance 740 establishing regulations for the installation, inspection, and maintenance of on lot sewage disposal systems;

WHEREAS, section 16 of ordinance 740 describes a program for the regular pumping of on lot sewage disposal systems, known as the Sewage Management Program (SMP);

WHEREAS, section 20.B. of ordinance 740 provides for a fee schedule associated with the SMP;


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, and it hereby is resolved, that the following rates have been set for the SMP:


- 1) \$65.00 for each property served by on-lot sewage disposal, except for properties that are subject to a maintenance agreement as specified further in item 2 below.
  - a) A 2% discount will be allowed for payment on or before April 30.
  - b) A 10% penalty will be added for payment after June 30.
- 2) If an on lot sewage disposal system is subject to a maintenance agreement as described in section 9 of ordinance 740, the fees associated with that maintenance agreement and administration of section 9 will apply.
- 3) Fees with respect to on lot sewage system design, permitting, and construction observation; testing for on lot system(s), subdivision and land development; and appeals are addressed by separate resolution(s).
- 4) This Resolution shall take effect with the billing of 2020 and shall remain in effect until otherwise further adjusted or amended by the Board of Commissioners.

This Resolution is a written reaffirmation of actions taken by the Board of Commissioners at a lawfully advertised meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Cumru.


