REQUEST FOR SEWER CREDIT FOR METERED RESIDENTIAL SEWER ACCOUNTS

*FOR SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS,

NOT ALL PROPERTIES AND CIRCUMSTANCES ARE
ELIGIBLE FOR SEWER CREDIT.*

In order for the Township to consider a request for sewer credit, an application form completely filled out and signed, proof of repair, and interim payment must be received at the Township administration office by close of business on the due date of the disputed sewer bill.

If the application, proof of repair, and interim payment are not received by the deadline, then the request for sewer credit will not be considered and interest will begin to accrue on the original billed amount.

- Proof of repair consists of an invoice from a plumber with a Pennsylvania Home Improvement Contractor's registration number.
- Interim payment is: two (2) times the average of the previous eight (8) quarterly bills prior to the disputed sewer bill.

- The Township may take up to 45 days to investigate an application for sewer credit. The applicant will be notified of the result.
